Annual 9/11 Memorial

The Ohio University College Republicans have gathered on College Green in the early hours of the morning for over two decades now to place two thousand, nine hundred and ninety-six flags in memory of those lost in the September 11th terror attacks.

This year, the memorial nearly faced vandalism and desecration as leftist students on campus believed it to be a memorial for Charlie Kirk, who was assassinated just the day prior. Thankfully, no such vandalism occurred thanks to the OUCR volunteers who kept vigil and stayed by the memorial throughout the day.
